



## **MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS**

### **WISA®-Pro lacquered pine flooring 28x145**

**The lacquer applied: 100% UV lacquer**

#### **Removal of stains**

As a rule, the maintenance of surfaces ready lacquered at mill is easy and does not require any special detergents. In most cases, water and a mild detergent is enough. If the stain or dirt is due, for example, to marker pen ink or some other substance that is difficult to remove, you could try a window cleaning agent that contains alcohol. **N.B.!** The cleaning agent must be watered down before use.

No abrasives should be used to clean lacquered surfaces. Also strong solvents, such as acetone, damage the lacquer coating. The amount of water used should be minimal and the surface must always be dried immediately after cleaning so that water cannot penetrate below the coating, for example through veneer joints or possible damages in the lacquer coating.

#### **Maintenance of a lacquered surface**

- If the surface is damaged and needs repairing, you should start with light sanding.
- As top coat you should use water-dilutable polyurethane-alkyd varnish or polyurethane-acrylic varnish. Don't use any other types of varnish because their adhesion may not be sufficient.
